Sparkling Wines and Champagnes

France

Blanc de Blancs Vin Mousseux, Simonnet Febvre

NV £26.50

This well respected house in Chablis is still the only producer to make sparkling wine on site. The vineyards are only a short distance from the Champagne region and the method of production is broadly the same.

Perrier-Jouet Grand Brut

NV £47.50

Made from 40% Pinot Noir, 40% Pinot Meunier, 20% Chardonnay. This wine shows fine, consistent bubbles with floral, honeyed fruit aromas. White peaches on the palate and an elegant finish.

Cremant De Bourgogne Brut Rose

NV £29.50

Made from 100% Pinot Noir, this Cremant is made in exactly the same way as Rose champagne.

Canard Duchene, Cuvee Leonie

NV £40.00

A blend Of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Exotic fruits, buttery aromas. Spicy and rich with good depth and maturity.

Italy

Prosecco Brut Valdese Terre di Sant' Alberto Veneto

NV £25.50

A classic Prosecco with a fine mousse and a fresh green pear character .

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White Wine

France

Vermentino Vieilles Vignes Les Archeres Pays d'Oc 2010 **£19.50**

100% Vermentino. Floral, peachy and white blossom aromas are met with a soft, creamy palate.

De Chansac Sauvignon IGP Cotes De Gascogne 2010 **£23.50**

Highly aromatic wine full of green fruit aromas mixed with capsicum. The palate is crisp; broad textured and has great intensity. Crisp and bone dry.

Chateau Les Clauzots Graves Blanc 2010 **£29.00**

70% Sauvignon Blanc, 30% Semillon. Fresh lemon, with ripe melon fruit, followed by a crisp, mineral finish and a hint of smoke. The palate is medium bodied and refreshing, with grassy citrus fruits and hints of wax and a long fine finish .

Grand Ardeche Chardonnay 2009 **£27.50**

A barrel aged Chardonnay, rich, buttery and full flavoured that offers exceptional value for money .

Muscadet Sevre Et Maine, Ducs de Bretagne 2010 **£21.00**

Characteristic green apple and citrus producing a classic Muscadet which is dry, light and rich from a little sur lie ageing .

Macon Villages, Louis Cheveville 2009 **£25.50**

Classic Burgundian Chardonnay produces this exceptional wine. A little oak and a rich buttery taste makes this a pleasure to drink.

Chablis. Domaine de la Conciergerie Christian Adine 2010 **£35.00**

100% Chardonnay. Pale lemon coloured, the nose shows a smoky minerality and aromas of pear and toffee apple. The palate is fresh and intense, with medium body, ripe apple fruit flavours and a crisp mineral finish .

Montagny La Grande Roche, 1er Cru 2009 **£39.00**

Lots of fruit flavours on this great wine from Louis Latour. Elegance and power in equal measure.

Sancerre Domaine Franck Millet 2010 **£39.00**

Dry and fruity with a flinty quality and an intensely aromatic nose of leaves and herbs .

Picpoul De Pinet, Domaine De La Viste, Coteaux De Languedoc 2010 **£23.00**

Refreshing and invigorating dry white wine, sourced from vineyards bordering the Etang de Thau, near Sete in the south of France .The nose is tropical fruit, then mineral hints. The palate is well balanced, between a great smoothness and a zesty citrus acidity.

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White Wine

Argentina

Vinas Riojanas Torrontes La Rioja 2010 **£19.50**
 100% Torrontes. The nose is full of aromas of roses, grapefruit and white peach. The palate is fresh and very fruity, with hints of tropical fruit and fresh acidity.

Australia

Devlins Mount Chardonnay, Southern Australia 2010 **£22.50**
 Fresh and creamy textured unoaked chardonnay. Medium bodied with citrus and white peach flavours fine balanced acidity .

3 Amigos White McHenry Hohnen, Margaret River, Western Australia 2009 **£29.00**
 Based on three white grape varieties that are more commonly found in the Rhone valley, Marsanne; Chardonnay and Roussanne. Full flavoured but not overpowering it is another classic from the winemaker who founded Cloudy Bay .

Tatachilla Growers Semillon—Sauvignon Blanc 2009 **£21.00**
 From the McLaren Vale this blend produces a vibrant and refreshing wine with grapefruit, lemon and passion fruit tones.

Chile

Cambio 7 Chardonnay 2010 **£19.00**
 Pineapple and apricot are supported with skilful use of oak to give the palate extra depth .

Hungary

Via Fordulo Pinot Grigio, Neszemely 2010 **£19.50**
 100% Pinot Grigio, bright lemon in colour with pear and spice aromas. Full and ripe with refreshing acidity .

New Zealand

Wild Rock Infamous Goose Sauvignon Blanc 2011 **£25.00**
 Lots of ripe fruit on the pallet but none of the overpowering aromas that can sometimes spoil less well made wines from this region .

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White Wine

South Africa

2011 **£18.00**

Isono, Chenin Blanc

A zesty white wine with plenty of good fruit and well balanced acidity.

Spain

Terra Calida Blanco Bodegas Roqueta Catalunya

2010 **£20.50**

90% Macabeo, 10% Moscatel. Fresh, fragrant and dry best describe this elegant wine from North East Spain. The palate is medium to full bodied.

Rose Wine

France

Grenache Cinsault Le Cap de Capitouls Pays d'Oc

2010 **£23.50**

50% Grenache 50% Cinsault Medium-bodied on the palate with rose petals on the finish .

Melopee de Gavoty Rose, Cotes de Provence

2010 **£26.50**

60% Syrah, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon. The nose is of summer fruits, the palate is of strawberries and redcurrants, allied to a creamy texture, considerable weight and a long crisp finish .

South Africa

Isono Rose

2011 **£18.00**

Made from the Pinotage grape this is a very pale pink rose, with flavours of crushed strawberries and summer fruits. It is a dry wine and is at home with food or on its own .

Red Wine

France

2010 **£23.50**

Cotes du Ventoux Les Boudalles Domaine Brusset

Supple, elegant and harmonious. The aromatics give it a lift which can be very moreish – 60% Grenache 15% Mourvedre 15% Carignan 10% Clairette.

De Chansac Carignan IGP de l'Herault

2010 **£20.00**

100% Old vines Carignan. Spicy, smooth fruited Southern French red given added lustre from the gentle oak seasoning .

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Red Wine

France

Samur Rouge Charles de Villeneuve, Cave des Vignerons de Samur 2009 **£23.00**

100% Cabernet Franc makes this wine deep ruby red, with red fruits and spices and a hint of bergamot.

Domaine Du Vieux Parc, 'L'Alouette, Vin De Pays Hauterive 2009 **£22.00**

60% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon. Cassis and Damson fruit combine with a smoky complexity on the palate. Smooth texture with a lingering finish of ripe cherries; well-balanced wine.

Reflets du Chateau Cissac, Haut Medoc 2nd Wine of Chateau Cissac 2005 **£29.00**

Liquorice, mineral and tar aromas follow through to a medium body, with firm tannins and a clean finish.

Chateau Bernot Bordeaux AC 2009 **£22.00**

56% Merlot, 39% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc. Supple with generous plummy fruit and a classic Bordelais savour.

Beaume-de-Venise, Chateau Redortier 2006 **£35.00**

Abundant red fruits and spice in this rich red, from the region's best producer. A truly great wine.

Vacqueyras, Domaine le Clos des Cazaux 2009 **£36.00**

A lighter alternative to Chateaufort-du-Pape. A classic dry palate with rich warm fruit. Old wood is used in the maturation process.

Argentina

Finca Las Parades Malbec San Rafael 2011 **£22.50**

Classic Malbec aromas of ripe plums, tobacco and violets are evident in the nose, with hints of vanilla. Quite full on the palate, yet with soft ripe tannins, this has good balance and a long finish.

Australia

Devlins Mount Shiraz South Australia 2010 **£22.50**

Summer fruits, raspberry and toast on the nose. Full-bodied on the palate, with blackberry and plum flavours and hints of clove and very juicy tannins.

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Red Wine

Australia

3 Amigos Red, McHenry Hohen, Margaret River, Western Australia 2009 **£29.00**
Shiraz, Grenache and Mataro blend. Full of spice and rich fruit flavours it is a wonderful example of the fine quality wines that Australia is now producing.

Tatachilla Partners Cabinet Shiraz McLaren Vale 2009 **£21.00**
Delicate nose, for a powerful dark fruit wine with a hint of vanilla oak .

California

Furious Boar Old Vine Zinfandel 2006 **£19.50**
Bursting with blueberry, spice and vanilla oak, this wine is big and bold with intense fruit .

Merlot, Lucky Horseshoe Hayes Ranch, Central Coast 2008 **£27.50**
81% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Barbera, 2% Petit Verdot, the nose has herbal, raspberry and plum fruit. The palate is ripe plummy fruit, hints of spice and ripe tannins .

Chile

Cambio 7 Merlot 2010 **£19.00**
Notes of tobacco and spices on the nose with dark soft fruits on the palate. Good balance and tannins make this wine suitable for all occasions.

Italy

Barbera Riva Leone, Piemonte 2009 **£21.00**
Flavours of black and red berries as well as a touch of dried fruit held together in a light body.

New Zealand

Hunter's Pinot Noir Marlborough 2009 **£37.00**
An elegant, smooth and well-balanced wine with cherry, plum and spicy overtones. Complex, sophisticated and subtle, with a silky texture and long finish.

South Africa

Isono Shiraz-Cinsault 2011 **£18.00**
A soft red with good tannins. Soft black fruits and a hint of vanilla oak make this a great value wine for most dishes .

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Dessert

France

Muscat de Beaumes de Venise Vidal Fleury 2009 **£40.00**
Glorious grapey fruit aromas combine with well-balanced acidity on the finish to make this the perfect match to any pudding.

South Africa

Rhona Muscadel, Graham Beck 2008 **£20.00**
A beautifully perfumed dessert wine with rich flavours of orange rind, prunes and raisins.

Port

Smith Woodhouse 10 year-old Tawny 1998 **£45.00**
Matured in oak casks, this Tawny Port drinks well at either room temperature or chilled. Dried fruit and toffee on the nose. Full bodied with strong fruit tones

Smith Woodhouse LBV 2003 **£40.00**
Bright deep ruby colour. Brimming with aromas of red and black berry fruits, with very attractive floral nuances and a twist of pepper. A full bodied palate, with intense fruit flavours, excellent grip and a long, lingering finish

Croft, Quinta da Roeda 1997 **£50.00**
Attractive liquorice, chocolate, and roasted coffee aromas, with a medium to full body and sweet tannins. Great value single quinta port from this well known estate in the heart of the Douro valley.

Corkage
